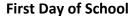

Staff will be ready to meet students outside where tentative class lists will be posted. Class lists will not be available in the office that morning as all staff will be helping with new registrations or will be outside welcoming students back. Please feel free to join us for the first part of the morning as we welcome our students back to another amazing school year.

We anticipate that our student numbers will change over the next couple days and weeks. Changes to class lists are likely to occur as we get to know our numbers and students better.

School Supplies

We are continuing the school supply program where families can purchase supplies through the school for \$40. We are fortunate to be able to access great discounts so the prices is greatly reduced compared to purchasing on your own. If you would like to purchase on your own, please connect with me by email and I can send a list out to you.

We also ask that all students bring a water reuseable water bottle and pair of running shoes to leave at school. We do have filtered water at the water fountains, but do not have extra cups or water bottles for students.

Personal belongings: Toys and Technology

We will continue to ask caregivers to check and make sure their child is not bringing toys to school. Toys often create a distraction in classrooms and get lost on the playground creating understandable grief. This applies to technology as well. If your child brings their phone to school, we ask that it is kept in their backpack for the entire day. Please have this conversation with your child so that they understand that this will be the expectation here at school. If there is an emergency, students can use the phone in the office.

Staffing

We are very fortunate to be starting the school year with a full staff, with many returning teachers and support staff. Please feel free to drop in at the end of the school days to say hello to our new and returning

staff members. We will also be connecting with all families in the first week of school to introduce ourselves. We are also working on plans for an Open House where we can spend time with families getting to know each other and showcasing our schools.
