At our school, we use restorative practices to help build a positive community and solve conflicts in a respectful way. Restorative practices focus on understanding each other's feelings and finding solutions that work for everyone involved. Instead of just giving punishments when someone makes a mistake, we try to bring everyone together to talk openly, share their feelings, and come up with a plan to make things right. Sometimes this also involves consequences, but restoration is always a part. This approach helps students learn from their actions, take responsibility, and

improve their relationships with others. By working together to solve problems, we create a safer, more supportive school where everyone feels valued and heard.
