- 1. Approval of Minutes
- a. Minutes from December 5, 2022 meeting approved. First and second by Bonnie & Kristi.

- a. Agenda adopted

- a. **Review of Past 3 Events this Year**: Scout Island Meet & Greet (30+ people). Downhill biking (15 + people), and Learning Day at Scout Island (30+ people). All these events were free for the PAC, but the PAC supported by providing food.
- b. **Treasurer's Report:** Bonnie reviewed how the PAC gets funding through a gaming grant meant to enhance children's education. As of December 1st, \$11, 299.60 in account. After Christmas party, it will be at about \$10,750. PAC will aim to have a \$4000 float.

4. Committee Report

Final event- Camp: Gavin Lake is tentatively booked for us on June 29th, 30th & 1st, and can prepare meals. Estimated cost for 2 nights is \$3100. Lake of the Trees is tentatively booked for us on May 6, 7, 8 and can prepare all meals. A poll has been sent out to families about which date is preferable, but not many responses. Ken clarified that this will be a fully PAC-sponsored event.

Action: PAC Exec will decided on a final date by January 31, 2023.

5. New Business

- a. **January Event-X-country skiing in WL**: Tuesday, January 24: Lessons & Practice in the field (9 a.m.-2:30 p.m.). Cost will be \$15/child (covered by GROW). PAC will cover the cost of one parent for rental and pass. PAC will provide snacks & lunch, which include hot dogs and hot chocolate. Ken says that GROW will not be able to host a x-country skiing event in 100 Mile.
- **b. February Event-Downhill skiing:** Wednesday, February 8th. GROW will cover the pass and lessons. PAC will pay for the rentals of all GROW registered students. PAC will provide snacks & lunch.

<u>Action</u>: Ken will check if possible for GROW to pay for 1 parent pass & rentals as well.

For January, \$500 has been budgeted. For February event, \$1000 budgeted.

- c. **March event (potential)** Elementary with Virginia/Older students swim/ Friday art class
- 6. Principal's Report
- a. **Overview-** There are 96 students enrolled in GROW, including high school students. Students in Grade 8-9 are more online. Reports card went out in December. Virginia Ivey is offering a Primary Social for Learners K-Gr.4 on Friday mornings. Ken clarifies that there is no funding for a GROW teacher to work from 100 Mile.
- b. **Ukulele Lessons** Ken said there is an opportunity for Gr. 4 and up to have ukulele lesson once a week online (1 hour each class). Can accommodate up to 30-40 students. Parents can use their GROW funds to purchase the ukulele. Cost of lesson paid for by PAC would be \$500/month to pay the instructor.
