 - -Approx. 98 students registered in GROW, but PAC events will be budgeted based on 30-40 students attending

 - -Ideas from parents: Dessert Hills in Ashcroft; Mt. Timothy for ski trip (Ken thought school might be able to pay for bus), art programming paired with gym days
 - -Events at Scout Island can be done for free

- -Lacey & Virginia: hope for mountain biking in October, PAC will provide snacks
- -Bonnie highlighted that the PAC would like to try to collaborate with the school in their events

a. Overview

- -K-7 parents coming in to get their packages
- -8-12 students success poor; encouraging some students back to school
- -8-12 students still in GROW will have more online group sessions to help with motivation
- -Students can no longer graduate through GROW from Gr.12; will need to access different distant learning school (option of on-line such as EBUS)
- -30 Skyline students enrolled with GROW this year, opportunity for PAC to invite them to Mt. Timothy or Bull Mountain event

- -Possibility of Distant Learning families invited to Artists in the School assemblies; would be posted on the GROW website
- -Possibility of weekly K-Gr. 3 activity mornings with Virginia; more information to come
