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Welcome back to school for 2022!

Extended Christmas Break and COVID-19 updates

We hope you all enjoyed an extended Christmas Break with the addition of last week. We had a productive week with staff at the school as we made preparations for the days and weeks ahead. One of the first things we attended to was updating our **School COVID-19 Safety Plan**. Please know that this document is a work in progress as we make adjustments to it as necessary. As we move forward in these uncertain times, our goal continues to be maximizing in-class instruction to minimize learning gaps and while providing the academic, social and emotional supports essential for learning. To maintain a healthy and safe environment for students, staff, and families the school continues to follow important safety and infection prevention control measures, such as:

- Daily health check:
 - We urge parents and caregivers to assess their child(ren) daily for symptoms of common cold, influenza, COVID-19, or other infectious respiratory disease before sending them to school.
 If a child has any symptoms, please do not send them to school.
 - The K-12 Daily Health Check web link (https://www.k12dailycheck.gov.bc.ca/healthcheck?execution=e1s1) is working again.
 - Please report absences as "Illness-related" to help us track illness-related numbers in our schoolwide attendance.

Masks:

- The PHO Order Face Coverings requires all students, staff and visitors to wear a mask indoors at school. Everyone who is able to (i.e., does not have a mask exemption) must wear a mask. If your child has an exemption, but can tolerate a mask for short periods of time, please encourage them to do so. Please ensure you are sending your child to school with a properly fitting mask, and if possible, a back-up mask.
- Minimizing physical contact
- Hand and personal hygiene

Cold weather and winter clothing reminder

Parents, please note that our students go outside for recess, noon hour, and other activities throughout the day when the temperature is as cold as -15°C. However, students can be out in much colder weather while waiting for buses before and after school. School buses run regularly during winter weather, but delays are inevitable. Please ensure that children come to school prepared for our winter weather. There is no longer any set temperature when school buses do not run, so parents are encouraged to listen to the local radio station or check the school district web site as bus cancellations are usually announced by 7:00 AM.



Kindergarten Registration & School of Choice process

(To commence Monday January 17, 2022)



a) Kindergarten Registration

Children must be five years of age by December 31, 2022. Children presently enrolled in Kindergarten at our school do not need to re-register for Grade One.

A Birth Certificate or Passport, BC "Care Card", and 2 Pieces of Proof of Address are required for registration.

Students are required to register at the school in their catchment area. Parents not sure of their catchment area are requested to contact the nearest elementary school, the School District Office, or our website at www.sd27.bc.ca for this information. Please contact your catchment school for a registration appointment. A catchment area finder is available on the district website (click on Schools, then School Locator).

b) School of Choice Process

All elementary and rural elementary-secondary schools in the School District have a designated "catchment area." If you wish your child to attend a school that is not their catchment school, a School of Choice application must be submitted.



- I) Applicants must be registered at their respective catchment school **BEFORE** submitting a School of Choice application.
- 2) Application forms may be obtained at all schools, the School District Office, or on the School District's website (www.sd27.bc.ca).
- 3) Parents will assume responsibility for travel and any additional costs incurred by a School of Choice approval.
