# Terry Fox Run: A new bar has been set!

as he brought in \$435 of donations! What an amazing job, Augustus! As a token of our appreciation, we awarded Augustus with a Terry Fox Run shirt for his efforts. Ms. Dahl's class was awarded a food prize for being the class that raised the most money. Another one of our new students, Riley Burgess, ran the farthest by completing 20 laps of our 400



plus meter fitness trail. Well done and congratulations, Riley! Thank you to students, staff, and our school community in helping to make this year's run a success and for helping our school make a significant contribution to the Terry Fox Foundation.

### New mask mandate and exemptions

As you all know by now, the public Health Authority has recently mandated the use of masks for students from grades K -12. A number of families have asked for mask exemptions for their children. Please understand that if your child has been granted a mask exemption, whether a partial or full exemption, there is an expectation that families will take on more of the responsibility for educating their child/children on the other protective measures, such as frequent hand-washing and physical distancing. It is also an expectation that the student will be diligent in their practice of these measure when not wearing a mask. Keeping children home when sick is another important line of defense, so thank you to all of you have been doing this. Teachers are making efforts to schedule more breaks in the day where students can take their masks off. This can mean taking the kids outside more often, so please ensure that your children are dressed for the outside weather conditions.
