



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Classroom Configurations

Our class lists are carefully planned as a team and includes extensive discussions regarding the best possible configuration to enhance learning. Several factors are considered including best fit with teaching style, social dynamics within the environment, learning styles, strengths, and stretches. Balanced classrooms with mixed ability groupings are the goal. When planning classroom placement, we work with class size and configuration standards. Based the numbers in our building our configuration is posted below. Tomorrow morning your child will learn about who their classroom teacher is and will start to settle into the new school year.

This is always an exciting day but learning a new classroom can also cause some stress. Please help your child(ren) to embrace the changes they will be experiencing and help them to work through the natural response of feeling a bit uncomfortable or nervous on the first day or two was they get to know a new classroom community.
