Columneetza/Nesika Bus Lane Expectations

- 1. Students will stand behind the yellow line.
- 2. One supervisor will monitor the cross-walk.
- 3. Students will **wait behind the yellow line** for the bus doors to open.
- 4. Columneetza/Nesika students will allow any **students to exit** the bus.
- 5. Students will wait to be **invited** on board by the driver.
- 6. Students will take care of each other by **allowing younger students** on to the bus first.
