Drop off and Pick up in the Vehicle Loop/Laisser et ramasser ses enfants:

Kindergarten Registration/Inscription à la maternelle:

Kindergarten registration for September 2024 begins <u>January 29, 2024.</u> Children <u>MUST</u> be five years of age by December 31, 2024. A <u>Birth Certificate or Passport, a BC Care Card and two pieces of proof of address are required at registration. Children presently enrolled in Kindergarten do NOT need to re-register for Grade 1.</u>

<u>Please Note/Notez bien:</u> Students **NOT** living in the Nesika Elementary catchment area <u>MUST</u> submit a "School of Choice" application if wishing to enroll in a Kindergarten program at Nesika. (This applies even if you already have another child already attending Nesika).

Registration and School of Choice applications <u>MUST</u> be completed at the <u>CATCHMENT AREA SCHOOL</u>

Parents wishing for their child to attend a school that is **NOT** their catchment school **MUST** fill out a "School of Choice" application and submit it before the **March 15, 2024,** deadline. **School of Choice Applications will be available starting January 29, 2023.**


