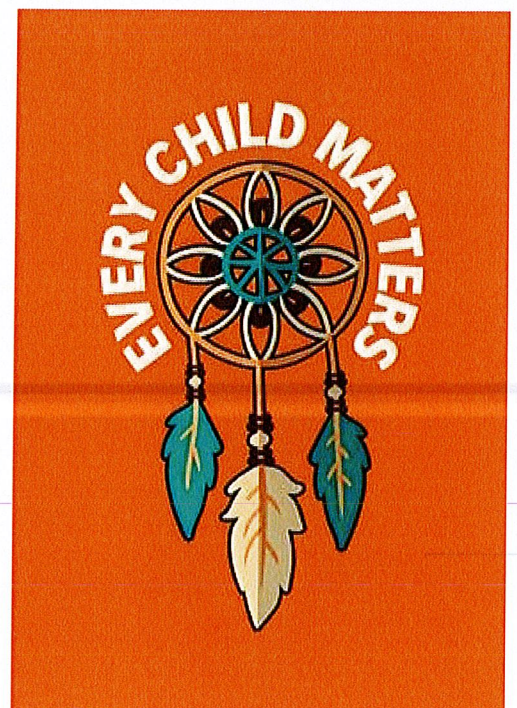


## ORANGE SHIRT DAY

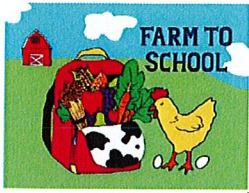
On Thursday, September 29<sup>th</sup> we are asking that all staff and students wear orange in support of the “Every Child Matters” program.

## CROSS COUNTRY RUN

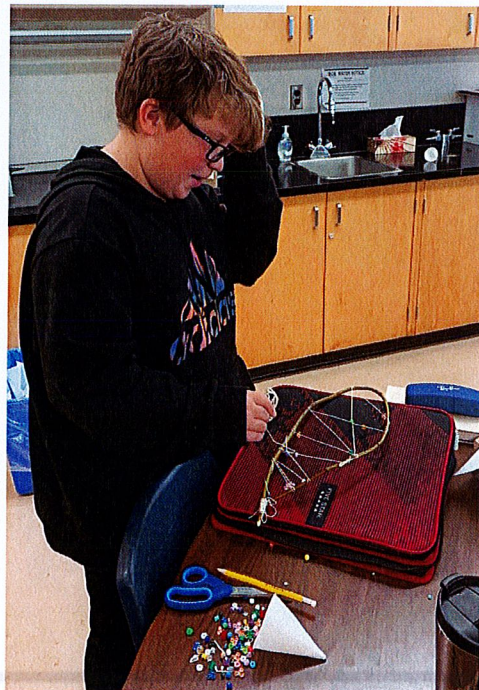
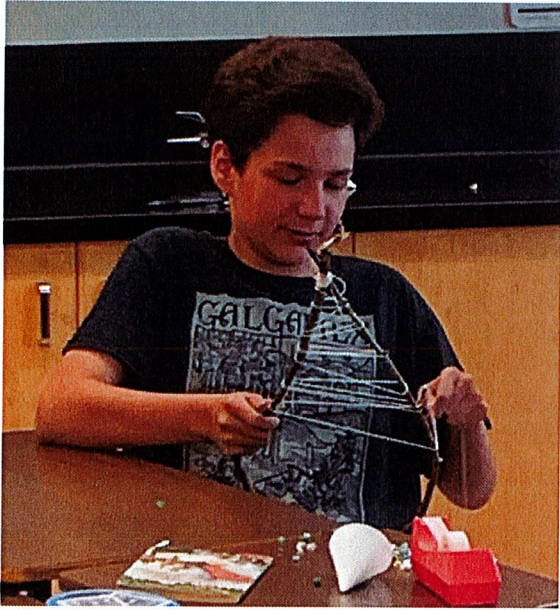

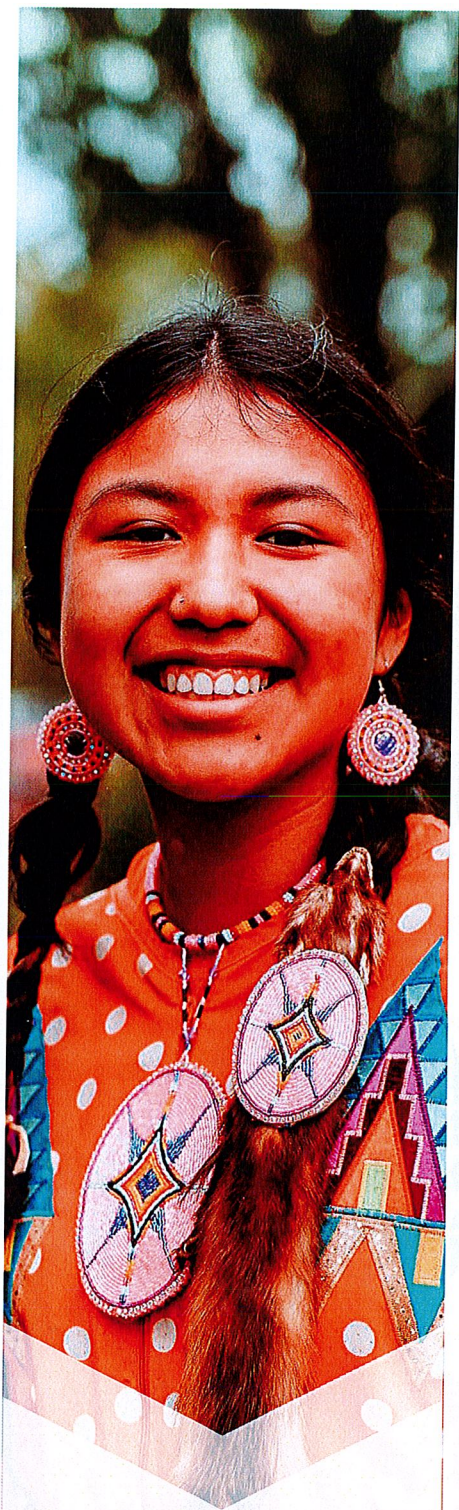
