## JUNIOR FIRE CREW

Students learn wildfire fighter skills, receive various training certificates and an opportunity to obtain 1 of 4 Jr Fire Crew positions with the BC Wildfire Service. Only 16 students accepted into this program.



## HEAVY METAL ROCKS

Students attend a multi-day activity and gain firsthand experience operating up to 24 pieces of Heavy Equipment. They receive First Aid Level 1, WHMIS, and safety training. Apply mid-January to mid-February. A maximum of 24 students are accepted into the Williams Lake program and 12 students are accepted into the 100 Mile program.



## YOUTH TRAIN IN TRADES

Providing high school students the opportunity to work towards completion of an apprenticeship or industry training program while receiving credits towards graduation.



## YOUTH WORK IN TRADES

Students gain hours toward their future apprenticeship, as well as school credits, for their part-time position working with a recognized tradesperson. Students must be 15 years of age or older. Students who meet requirements are qualified for a \$1000 award.



## DUAL CREDIT PROGRAMS:

### HEALTH CARE ASSISTANT APPLIED SUSTAINABLE RANCHING

Delivered in partnership with Thompson Rivers University, these programs provide secondary students the opportunity to begin post-secondary training in their grade 12 year of high school. Students receive "Dual Credit" with the transferability of grades received in post-secondary training to high school credit.



## RCMP YOUTH ACADEMY

Students attend an RCMP boot camp, where they will experience police training and participate in police work simulations. Apply early December when offered, only 24 students accepted



## YOUTH DISCOVER THE TRADES - Youth

Exploring Skills to Industry Training

Students work with trade specific journeypersons, SD27 trades teachers and TRU trades instructors rotating through the following trades: carpentry, welding, electrical and millwrighting.

Young students work with older students to gain hands on learning in various trades industries.
