Position: YOUTH ENGAGEMENT WORKER

Location: Forest Grove Elementary, Mile 108 Elementary, Horse Lake Elementary

- Connect students to appropriate supports in the school and in the community whenever necessary
- Help students network to build support in their community
- Network and collaborate with community partners to share resources and community events
- Act as a liaison between students, families, community and school
- Provide educational resources around mental health, sexual health and drug prevention
- Collaborate with teachers to build and support the behaviour plan and goals for the student (Student's personal profile)
- Support and model appropriate school behaviours as defined by the school's Code of Conduct and/ or matrix

- Support the students with all their learning needs in the classroom (educational, social, emotional)
- Other duties as assigned
