Between 10:30 am – 12:00 pm Ms. Shaw's and Ms. Simcox's classes perform.

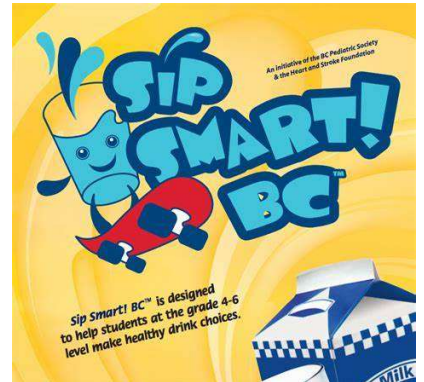
