

École 100 Mile Elementary Hot Lunch Program



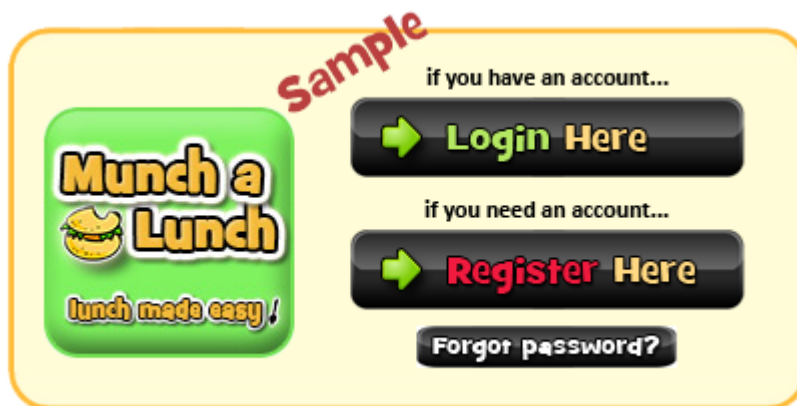
Hello Parents!

We are happy to announce that you will now place your hot lunch orders online using **MunchaLunch.com!**

You can pay for your orders online by credit card OR debit-credit card or pre-paid credit card.

HOW TO REGISTER:

- 1) Go to: <https://munchalunch.com/schools/100mile>
- 2) Click the “**Register Here**” button (as shown below). The system will guide you through.
- 3) After adding your children, click the green “Order Lunch!” button to order.
- 4) Next time, just click the “**Login Here**” button to access your account.



ORDERING INFORMATION:

- Please pay attention to dates. Once the order is closed, adjustments cannot be made. This is so that we ensure we have enough for everyone that ordered.
- If you need assistance with ordering, please come by the office and we can help you set up your account.
