presentation!

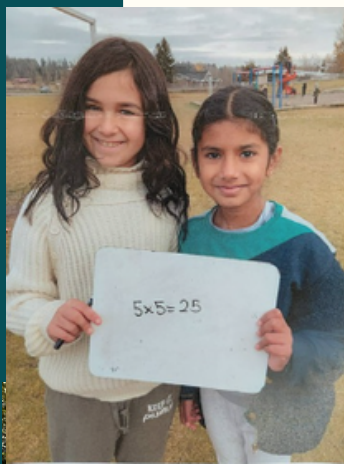




Outdoor Education This Month
