# C. REPORTS:

## i) Assistant Superintendent's Report: Cheryl Lenardon

• Cheryl passed on her report as she has nothing additional to Chris' report. Also she will present her FESL presentation.

# ii) Superintendent's Report: Chris van der Mark

• Chris provided a Covid-19 Update for our District.

Federal Covid-19 Funding:

In the fall we discussed what to do with the Federal dollars coming our way. Chris showed a power point entitled 'Project Update' showing the outdoor classroom spaces that will be built at all 22 schools. He added that the District also had significant Technological issues due to equipment being outdated. Those two were identified as key pieces for the use of the Federal Funding.

#### iii) Finance, Facilities & Transportation Committee Report: Chris Van der Mark

- This committee met on February 9, 2021.
- Chris said the big focus was the amended budget that was passed. The key part was that due to the pandemic, enrollment is down. We are optimistic of a normal fall but if students do not enroll in the fall, this could provide a significant budget change.
