ii) Feeding Futures input from FNEC: Cheryl Lenardon

\$600,000 for food to be provided this next school year. The needs are so different from school to school. We have asked the schools for their feed back on this. Does FNEC have any suggestions?

FNEC asked about addition of Traditional Foods. We did take that into consideration. All schools will be proposing. Some schools do breakfasts, some lunch. Some provide snacks.

This is food for only the kids who need it. Not a full school. It needs to be stigma free. (e.g. could be a punch card).
