ii) First Nation Role Models: Tracy Hubner

- Role Model Registrations are out still, we have received 2 applications so far.
- The 2021 Role Model Ceremony is back on the LCS (WL) Website.
- Difficult to get registration booths set up in schools due to Covid. Will monitor this. Several staff at the high schools are encouraging the students.

iii) Local Artists list: Grant Gustafson

Grant has started gathering information (local artists list).

This list will go to the schools. We are looking at a model to allocate the money to the schools and encourage them to pursue these Elder visits. We could look at doing some stuff remotely as well to provide the students some experiences and protect the Elders. The list of Elders will be on the SD27 staff portal so school staff can see. We will also get the list out to FNEC.

iv) Welcome Signage: Grant Gustafson

Grant will reach out to the communities.

v) LAKE CITY SECONDARY: Logos for Bands at both campus'

The school is seeking permission to print these logos off for each Band and put in a prominent place in the school.

Honorarium Structure: Grant Gustafson

Grant Gustafson sent SD27 Indigenous Education Honoraria Structure out to FNEC and will ensure schools use this. Schools can pay more for presenters if need be. Dancing Water Sandy is putting together gift packs for schools to present to the Elders.

FNEC said that this is good to go as is.

vi) St. Joseph Mission finding:

WLFN to make announcement regarding this on Dec. 10. Community's need different levels of support. We are giving information to teachers to support the students re this.

Whatever we can do to support this – SD27 willing to do. Counsellors will be in place.

SD27 staff need to be prepared for students and SD27 staff affected too.

Grant will try to organize something like a moment of silence.
