The contest is open to ALL students Kindergarten to Grade 12 regardless of ethnicity. **They do not have to be Indigenous, Inuit or Métis students!**

Please note. Once we receive the poems, they are categorized and entered on spreadsheets. When the contest closes, the poems are then given to the judges who will read each one. The judges require approximately 3-4 weeks for this process.

As soon as we know the winners, we will notify everyone.
