STUDENT SUCCESS

This first year of the plan we are working from the Ministry data set provided for 2019-2020 and also looking at the data we have available for 2020-2021. This gives us some indications of general trends but we are aware of the limitations of our previous data. We have identified a need for professional learning around assessment, data governance, and creating a culture where common information sets are valued as useful for collaborative planning. Part of the work of the plan is to improve the validity, reliability, and use of student data in the district. We are working with schools to ensure data in the student information system, including attendance, is taken and entered in the same way across schools, common standards and understandings are the basis for report card marks, and district assessments are administered and scored consistently. As the results of provincial assessments and surveys are used to inform instruction and school planning, the commitment to the quality of the information they provide will grow. The 2021-2022 school year will provide a more accurate baseline picture of the student success in our district.

Cohorts

One of the limitations of looking at the FESL measures and comparing year to year is that they are results for different groups of students. This means it takes a number of years to see a clear trend. We are building a data warehouse so that we can retain information about our students in cohorts to track their success from their Grade 4 FSA to their Grade 7 FSA and Graduation Assessments, their survey results in Grades 4, 7, 10, and 12, and their attendance and success in Language Arts and Math on report cards from Kindergarten to Grade 12. We have a unique local measure that combines Language Arts, Math, and Attendance as a research-based predictor of the degree to which students are on-track for future graduation based on their current success at any given time. This is important for individual student and cohort tracking. 2021-2022 is our starting point where we will have some confidence in our data and begin tracking it in a way that will let us answer questions about growth over time.

Data System

We have a new locally developed data system that transforms the data in the student information system (MyEd) into displays that include charts and lists of students that can be sorted, filtered on a number of factors, and provide alerts. The secure dashboards provide district, school, and class views depending on the level of access of the viewer. It is available now at the start of the school year to support School Plans and will be available to classroom teachers this Fall. Development will continue on dashboards and reports to support unique school needs.

Targets

We will introduce a process for schools to set individual student targets for success in literacy, numeracy, attendance, and sense of belonging in the 2022-2023 school year. We will aggregate those individual targets up to set district targets based on the actual plans for students. In the current year the target is to establish a reliable baseline. We will expect to see some improvement in this first year in attendance, sense of belonging and FSA results; we will have a complete set of district literacy results and report card marks to look at for triangulation with the provincial assessment results and begin to seek some alignment.
